Mr. Williams Introduces Flipped Format in Geometry



Mr. Ken Williams has introduced the flipped classroom format to teach Geometry at Saint Mary's. In the flipped classroom format, instead of lecturing in class and assigning homework, Mr. Williams assigns videos on a specific content for students to watch at home and also gives them a worksheet to take notes. When students come to class the following day, they discuss with Mr. Williams what they heard in the videos and he answers any questions they may have. The rest of the class time is spent practicing the concepts from the video by working on actual Geometry problems and doing activities to ensure the concepts introduced in the video are fully understood. A major advantage of this format is that it allows more time for teachers to interact with students and to provide individual help. For parents, it is also a great relief to know they don't need to help students solve Geometry problems at home, as Mr. Williams will assist them the following day!




